

CCSA TECHNIQUE CLASS 2010

3D Leaf Plate – Mary Ann O’Hearn

Ingredients

Bisque

1610 Square Coupe Dinner Plate

Color

FS 2300 Polar Bear
FS 2301 Smiley Face
FS 2303 Lime Ricky
FS 2304 Green Acres
FS 2314 Black Lab
FS 2341 Kermit
FS 2372 Mocha Fudge
FS 2392 Rockin’ Red

Brushes and other materials

6602 Ultimate II Round Brush #6
6600 Ultimate II Round Brush #1
6620 Ultimate II Detail #5/0
Round Synthetic Sponge



Directions

Step 1- Sponge 2 coats of Polar Bear to the top side of the plate.

Step 2- The background of this plate is all sponged from the center out using the round side of the sponge, going from light to dark colors (blending each color together) in this order: Polar Bear, Smiley Face, Lime Ricky, and Kermit. Lastly, trim the edge with Green Acres.

Step 3- Trace pattern of design onto the plate.

Step 4- The top two leaves are done in the same way. Sponge Smiley Face on the bottom side of the leaf, gradually going to Kermit on the top side of the leaf. On the fattest leaf on the bottom of the plate use the # 6 round brush. Apply two coats of Smiley Face at the bottom of the leaf and Lime Ricky at the top part of the leaf, blending them together in the middle. Side load the brush with very little Green Acres and do one side up the center of the leaf as seen in the photo. The other leaf at the bottom of the plate is also done with the # 6 round brush by applying one coat of Smiley Face with one coat of Lime Ricky on top of it. Use Green Acres to do the bottom half of the leaf but only do one streaked coat so it's not solid.

Step 5- Shading: Side load the # 6 round brush with Green Acres and shade the inside edge of the leaves. Only shade the top side of the leaves. The bottom side

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of all the leaves are shaded with Mocha Fudge. All the veins in the top two leaves are side load shaded with Green Acres.

Step 6- Lady Bugs: Use the # 6 round brush and apply 3 coats of Rockin' Red for one lady bug and Smiley Face for the other. To get a 3D effect with the lady bugs use Polar Bear to shade the bottom inside edge of each lady bug and Green Acres on the bottom outside edge. Using Black Lab and the 5/0 detail brush add the lady bug's head, antennae, dots and the center line on the lady bugs backside.

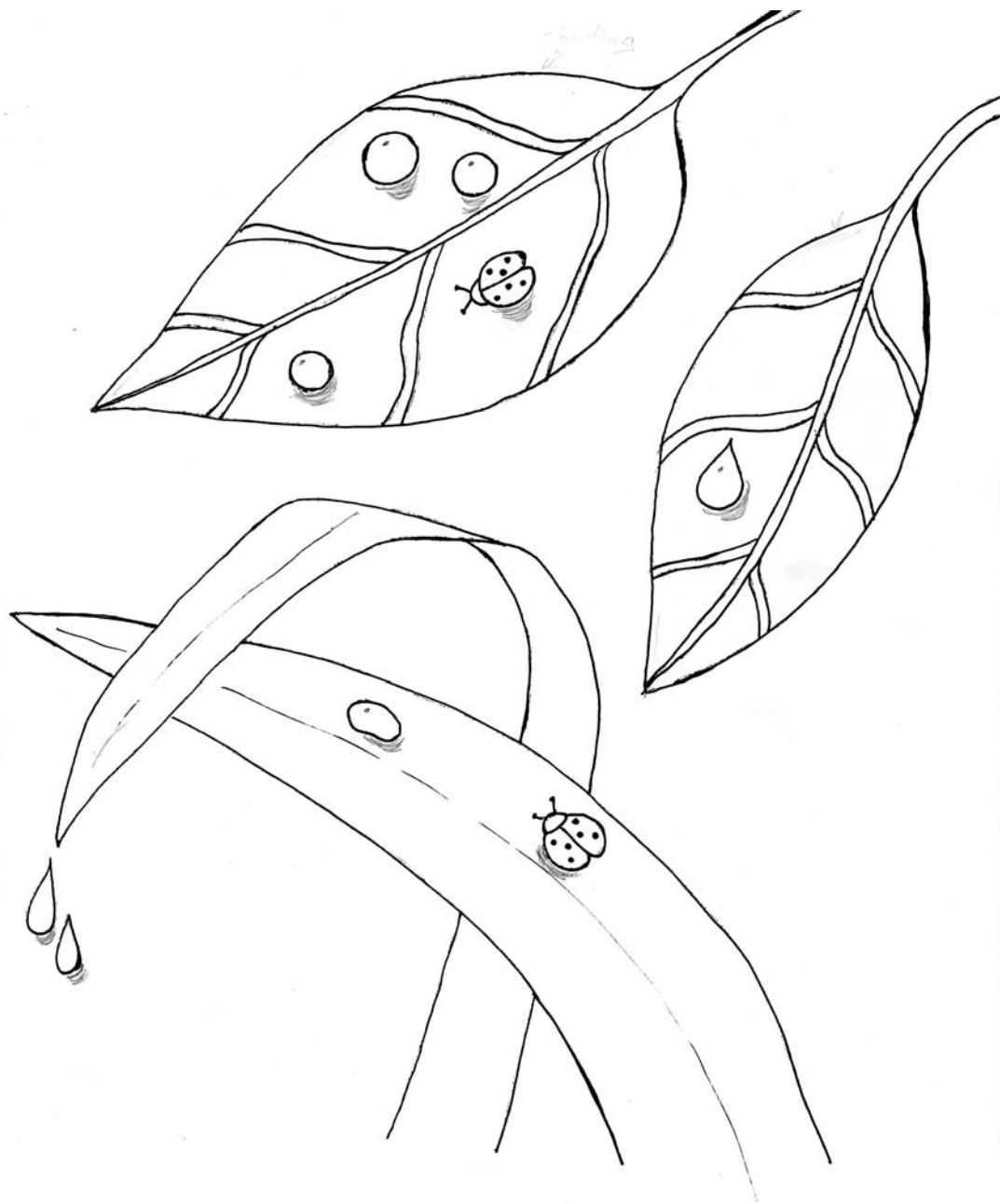
Step 7- Please refer to the video on our website titled "3D Water Droplets" to see how to do the water droplets. They are all done using the # 1 round brush, Polar Bear, Green Acres and Kermit.

Step 8- Optional: Apply 2 coats of Green Acres to the back side of the plate.

Step 9- Let dry and dip into Dazzle Dip clear dipping glaze. Fire to cone 06.

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
