Ingredients

Bisque:

#5095 Square Vase

Color:

FS-2313 Happy Trails
FS-2327 Blazing Saddle
FS-2337 Li'l Boy Blue
FS-2366 Chocolate Moose
FS-2372 Mocha Fudge
FS-2378 Pea Soup
FS-2395 Tin Man

Brushes and other materials:

6502 Colorstix Square Shader
6612 Ultimate II Round # 6

Square Sander
Letter Stamps
Sponge
Copy Paper
Ruler and Exacto Knife or
Paper Cutter



Directions

Step 1- Pour and roll Mocha Fudge to the inside of the vase. Tip upside down to drain. Clean up edges with a sponge (inside of vase is optional). Apply 2 coats of Tin Man to the outside of the vase. Let dry to the touch.

Step 2- Cut 4 ruler width strips of paper. Lay the vase on its side. Dip each strip into water and lay across the vase. Make sure you have a stripe across the top and the bottom as shown on photo. Press down with fingers so it is smooth on the vase. Tap with a damp sponge to get off the excess water. Let dry to the touch.

Step 3- Using a ruler and a pencil make stripes the width of the ruler around all four sides of the vase. Squeeze out five Fun Strokes colors on a palette. Apply one to two coats of a color to each stripe. Let dry. The dryer it is, the easier it is to sand off the color.

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Step 4- When the colors are dry enough. Use the square sander going in a vertical motion to take some of the color off....scuffing it up to give the look of old wood. Do not blow because it will create dust, just tap the vase onto a paper towel. When you are finished tap it lightly with a damp sponge to get any remaining dust. Don't do this too much or you will lose all your color.

Step 5- Using the Ultimate II # 6 round brush, side load Happy Trails and apply between all the lines. Peel off paper. Apply knots and extra lines in each wood panel. Use stamps with Happy Trails to apply letters.

Step 6- Dip into Dazzle Dip Clear Glaze and fire to cone 06.

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
