Ingredients

Bisque:

4019 Wine Cooler
5014 Rim Wine/Candle Holder
5108 Round Wine Topper w/Cork
5074 Round Coasters
4101 Red Wine Goblet
4100 White Wine Goblet
3028 Rectangular Coupe Platter
5098 Wide Spreader
5099 Narrow Spreader

Fun Strokes:

FS 2300 Polar Bear
FS 2301 Smiley Face
FS 2311 The Color Purple
FS 2314 Black Lab
FS 2375 Jumpin' Jelly
FS 2381 Be Boppin' Blue

Ultimate II- # 10

Directions

Note: These steps apply to all pieces. Also, you can do this with any city or town by going to Google.com and typing in "cityscape silhouette" and use as your pattern.

Step 1- This step is best if you can use a banding wheel but if you don't have one you can apply with a large round brush such as a Ultima II # 8 or Ultima II #10. Use the following colors from the bottom up, blending each color into each other going right over the cityscape design. You can add a little water to the glaze to help it blend a little better. Starting at the very bottom...Note: The paper

when wet sticks to color not bisque)...apply Smiley Face, The Color Purple, Jumpin' Jelly, Be Boppin' Blue and lastly Black Lab. Bring the Black Lab right up and over the edge of the piece to the inside. On two of the goblets I did the inside with Jumpin' Jelly and the other two with Be Boppin' Blue as you can see in the photo. Let this dry for 4 to 5 min. It should be dry to the touch.

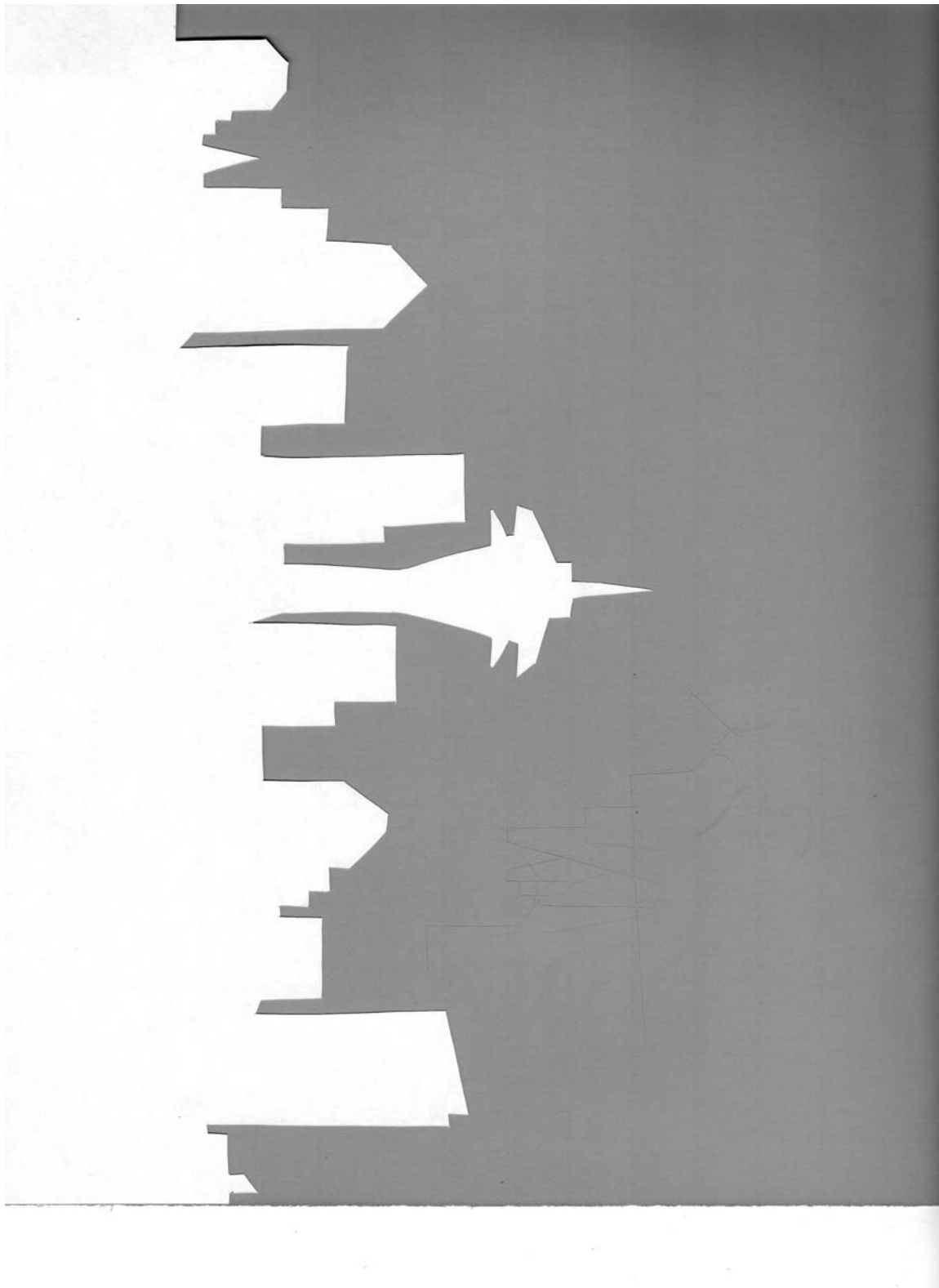
Step 2- (Refer to video on Gare.com under the "Videos & Tips" webpage for this step) Size and print pattern to fit your pieces. Put pattern on a cutting mat and cut with an exacto knife. (Refer to video for help with this part of the recipe) Be careful when cutting because you will be using the outside of the design you are cutting (not the city part). After you wet it, apply to the top area over the colors you just applied, and tap down with your fingers. Try to get smooth edges so when you apply the Black Lab it won't leak beneath the paper. Use a sponge to dab off excess water. Let dry for about 4 to 5 min, just until it's dry to the touch. It can still be a little damp.

Step 3- Peel off the paper. Now you can add little windows using the Fun Writer with Polar Bear. I also wrote "Out on the Town" on the edges of the pieces. Refer to photo. Clean up any Black Lab that might have got in the sky area using a cleaning tool. Make sure your glaze is very dry before doing this.

Step 4- Let dry. Dip into 9000D or Dazzle Dip and fire to cone 06.

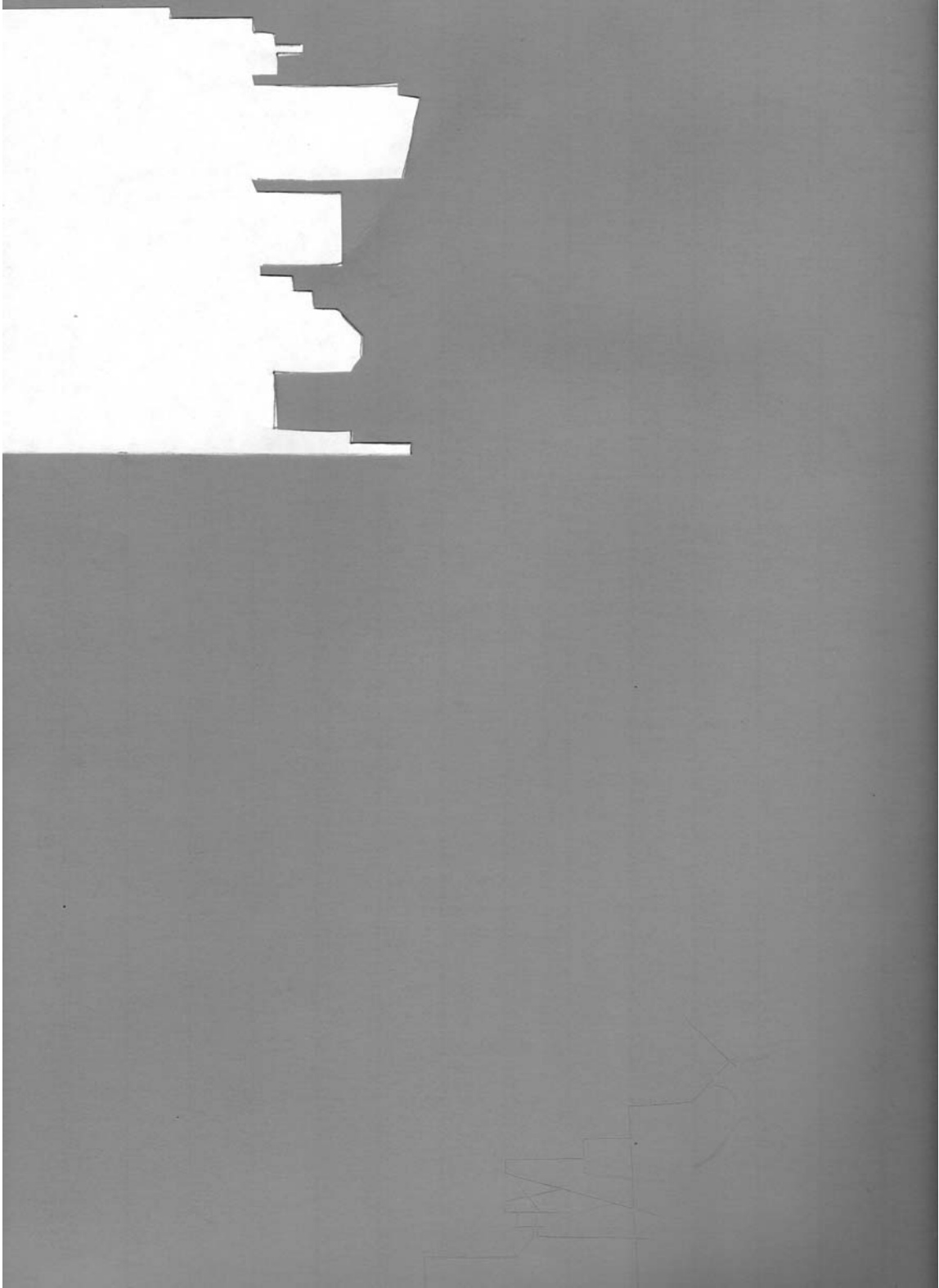
