Ingredients

7239-Electric Guitar Plaque
7236-Electric Guitar Bank
7237-Accoustic Guitar Bank

FS2409-Purple Rain
FS2311-The Color Purple
FS2305-Blue Heaven
FS2392-Rockin' Red
FS2315-What A Yolk
FS2314-Black Lab
FS2335-Tickled Pink

ColorStix Soft Fan Brush-65041
Assorted brushes to get desired effect
Fine gauge sandpaper



Directions

To Make “Stickers”:

Print out patterns included with this recipe on regular paper and cut them out.
Dampen with water and “stick” onto bisque or apply to wet paint on bisque.

Electric Guitar

Step 1 - Apply 1 coat of Tickled Pink to lower right of guitar. Quickly paint some Blue Heaven right along side the Pink. Apply the peace cut out over the blue and pink. Continue applying “stickers” in this manner, using the picture for a color guide.

Step 2 - After all stickers are applied, cover body front of guitar with 3 coats of Purple Rain.

Step 3 - Paint back body and neck of guitar in 3 coats of Black Lab.

Step 4 - Paint plate of guitar in 3 coats of Tickled Pink.

Step 5 - Let dry and remove “stickers”.

Step 6 - Complete painting guitar using the picture for color placement.

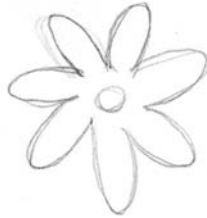
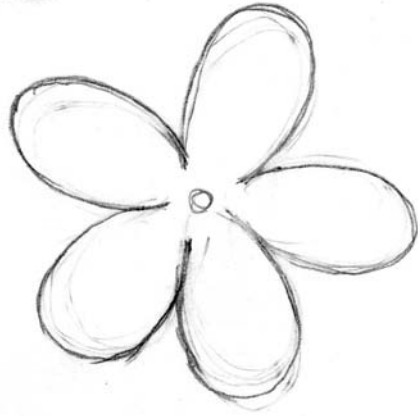
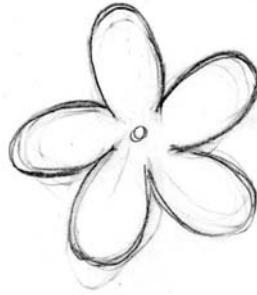
Step 7 - When completely painted and dry, gently rub over the top of the strings with the sand paper. This will remove the paint and allow the individual strings to show.

Let dry. Dip in Gare 9000D and fire to cone 06.

Paint other guitars depicted using the same colors and techniques. Use picture as color guide.
