7076-Sm Heart Box
7075-Med Heart Box
7074-Lg Heart Box

FS2300-Polar Bear
FS2392-Rockin' Red
FS2308-In The Pink
FS2384-Pinkie Winkie
FS2319-This Li'l Piggy
Fun Writers
ColorStix Soft Fan Brush #6541
ColorStix 6 #6505
Assortment of smaller brushes

Directions

I found this design by googling “paisley” designs in fabric. I copied the design onto my desktop, enlarged it and printed it. You must use a pattern right from the printer, not a copy. The copy will not have enough ink. I used the same pattern on each box top but changed the look by either rotating the design or enlarging or shrinking it.

Step 1- Cover the top of the heart with Polar Bear. Immediately press your pattern face down onto the white paint. Let dry. The more dry the paint, the better the impression left by the ink. There might be “crinkles” in the paint left by the paper shrinking. When the paint is dry, lightly sand these off.

Step 2- Fill in design using fun writers and brushes. Work on one area of the heart for a while and then move to another area. This allows the previous area worked on to dry so that new colors can be added without mixing with the old ones. Work in this manner until the entire front of plaque is covered. Let dry.

Step 3- Using the fan brush, paint back of plaque with 3 coats of Polar Bear. Let dry.

Dip in Gare 9000D and fire to cone 06.
