Ingredients

Gare Classic Coupe Dinner Plate # 1604

Soft Fan Brush

Liner Brush

Pattern

Scissors

Fun Writers

Fun Writer Medium Tips

FS-2373 Key Lime Pie

FS-2315 What-a-Yolk---in a Fun Writer Bottle

FS-2390 Orange Crush---in a Fun Writer Bottle

FS-2392 Rockin' Red---in a Fun Writer Bottle



Directions

Step 1- Apply 2 good coats of Key Lime Pie to the top of plate.

Step 2- Cut out pattern.

Step 3- Special Note: When doing this technique, you will need to do the large cut out a little different than the smaller ones. The smaller cut outs can be dipped into water and applied on top of the Key Lime Pie. The large cut out would be flimsy if you dipped it into the water so you will need to take the soft fan brush and wet it in the water and apply a coat of water on top of the Key Lime Pie. While it's wet, apply the large peace sign to the plate, dab with the sponge and smooth out a bit with your fingers. Now you can dip and apply the smaller peace sign and the flowers.

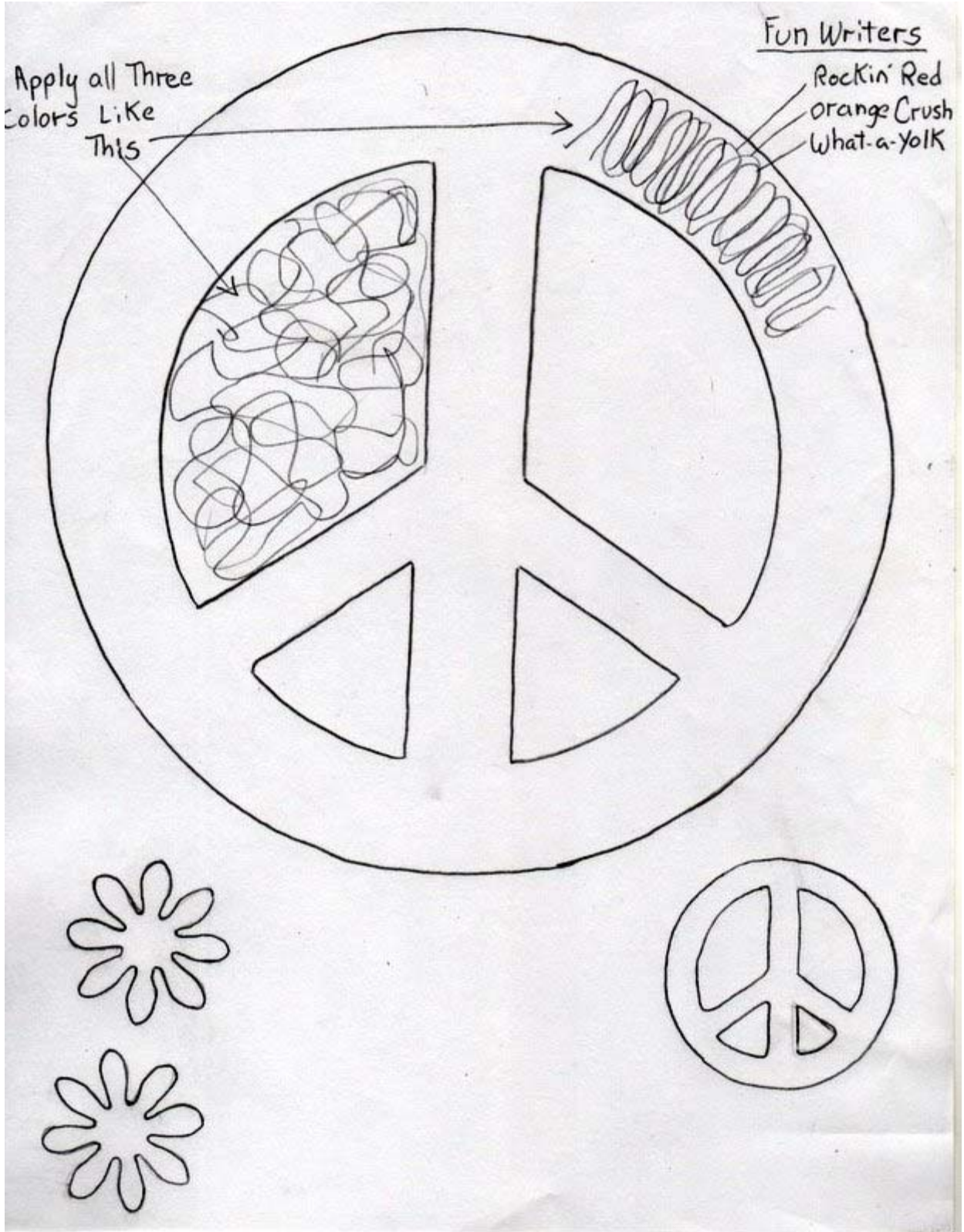
Step 4- To do the marbleizing with the Fun Writers, refer to pattern to see how to apply. Squeeze out each of the 3 colors, Rockin' Red, What-a-Yolk and Orange Crush to one of the center areas of the big peace sign as shown in the pattern. After you get a lot of color on there, use the liner brush to move it around and bring it together. Do each section of the peace sign.

Step 5- When doing the outside of the peace sign, apply as shown in the pattern. Use the liner brush to pull it together but just go in one direction if you want it to look like the sample.

Step 6- Pick off the paper patterns with a tool or a common pin. Dip into Gare 9000D clear glaze and fire to cone 06.

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
