

Olive Plates Using Matte Glaze

Ingredients

Bisque:

1014 Flare Ware Salad Plate

1015 Flare Ware Dinner Plate

Color:

NTG 9203 Cloud White - Matte Glaze

FS-2300 Polar Bear

FS-2314 Black Lab

FS-2366 Chocolate Moose

FS-2368 Old Yeller

FS-2378 Pea Soup

Brushes and other materials:

6541 ColorStix - 6 Soft Fan Brush

6508 ColorStix -12 Round Brush

6505 ColorStix – 6 Round Brush

6503 ColorStix – 4 Round Brush

6530 ColorStix - 1 Liner Brush

Dove paper pattern

Sponge

Copy Paper

Ruler and zacto knife or

Paper Cutter



Directions

Step 1- Apply 4 coats of Cloud White Matte Glaze to the entire salad plate using the ColorStix Soft Fan Brush. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the entire dinner plate also using the ColorStix Soft Fan Brush. Let dry to the touch.

Step 2- Cut 7 ½” strips of paper. Dip each strip into water and apply the first strip in the center of the dinner plate and work your way out from the center to get all 7 strips of paper on your dinner plate. Press down with fingers so it is smooth on the plate. Tap with a damp sponge to remove the excess water. Apply 3 smooth coats of Pea Soup to the top side of the dinner plate using the #6541 ColorStix – 6 Soft Fan Brush. Peel paper off and clean up any edges with a cleaning tool when it is dry. Cleaning works best when it's really dry.

Step 3- Cut the dove pattern from paper. Dip into water and apply near the top left hand corner of the salad plate. Dab with a damp sponge to remove the excess water.

Step 4- Squeeze out a quarter size each of Old Yeller and Pea Soup. Dampen the sponge with water and lightly apply a little of each color to the salad plate. Apply a little heavier around the dove so when you peel of the paper you can easily see the outline of the dove.

Step 5- Trace or draw the olive branch pattern to the salad plate. Squeeze out a quarter size of Chocolate Moose and apply stems and leaves using the #6505 ColorStix 6 Round Brush. This is just a shadow so once it's applied you want to take a damp sponge and dab the design lightly so that it lifts some of the color off.

Step 6- Squeeze out a quarter size each of Pea Soup and Chocolate Moose on a palette. Using a round brush of your choice, double load the two colors, one color on each side and apply a leaf stroke to one side of each of the shadow leaves you just applied. Also apply branches the same way. Using the #6503 ColorStix 1 liner brush and Chocolate Moose, connect each leaf to the branch. Apply a little shadow of Chocolate Moose on the edges of the dove very lightly.

Step 7- Squeeze out a quarter size of Black Lab and dip your finger into it and apply randomly to the plate for the olives. When it's dry apply a white highlight to each olive using a round brush that you prefer. Refer to photo.

Step 8- DO NOT DIP Matte salad plate into Clear Glaze. Only dip the dinner plate with the stripes into Dazzle Dip Clear Glaze. Fire to cone 06.
