

Pottery Glaze Grid

Ingredients

Bisque:

#1042 Flare Sushi Medium Plate

2073 Mini Round Dish

Color:

NTG 9516 Midnight Stone

NTG 9526 Ginger Blue

NTG 9528 Sandalwood

Brushes and other materials:

#6550 ColorStix Oval Mop

Sponge

Copy Paper

Ruler and Exacto Knife or

Paper Cutter

Fun Writer filled with Midnight

Stone



Directions

Step 1- Apply 3 generous coats of Sandalwood to the entire plate. Apply 3 coats of Ginger Blue to the small dish. Let dry to the touch.

Step 2- Cut 3 1" strips of paper and 3 1 ¼" strips. Dip one of the 1 ¼" strips into water and lay across the center of the plate horizontal. Press down with fingers so it is smooth on the plate. Tap with a damp sponge to remove the excess water. Apply the other two 1 ¼" strips, one on the top and one on the bottom. Refer to photo. Repeat the above using the 1" strips going in the vertical direction.

Step 3- Once it is dry to the touch, apply 3 coats of Midnight Stone to 8 squares (every other) and 3 coats of Ginger Blue to the rest of the squares. Peel off paper (you can do this after about 3 minutes).

Step 4- Using the Fun Writer filled with Midnight Stone, apply dots to the intersection of each square as shown in photo.

Step 5- Apply 3 coats of Midnight Stone to the inside of the small dish going around the rim and half way down the outside of the dish.

Step 6- DO NOT DIP POTTERY GLAZES. Stilt and fire to cone 06.
