Christmas Kitty

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

7099 Cat Pencil Cup Holder

FUN STROKES

FS- 2300 Polar Bear

FS- 2304 Green Acres

FS- 2308 In The Pink

FS- 2314 Black Lab

FS- 2315 What-a-Yolk

FS 2319 This Li'l Piggy

FS- 2341 Kermit

FS- 2374 Blue Ice

FS- 2381 Be Boppin Blue

STEP 1- Apply 2 coats of Polar Bear to the entire kitten. (only if you want the kitten to be whiter than the bisque color) going down inside about half way. This will also make it easier to shade.

STEP 2- Apply 1 coat to the insides of the ears and to the nose.

STEP 3- Shading: - Load a # 4 round brush, dip into water, dab off on a paper towel just once so there is still some water in your brush. Now slide a side of the round brush down the edge of the color In The Pink, and apply to all the creases like between the toes, between the legs, mouth area and inside edges of the pink in the ears.

STEP 4- Trace or pattern or draw designs on kitten. The holly leaves are 1 light coat of Green Acres. The berries are Rockin Red, applied with the back of a small brush. The little lights are What-a-Yolk, Rockin Red, Be Boppin Blue and Kermit, 2 coats each. The ornament earrings are Be Bopin Blue with a Polar Bear Highlight and a What-a-Yolk cap. The eyes are one coat of Blue Ice. Pupils, lashes, outline, eyebrows and mouth lines are 1 coat of Black Lab.

STEP 5- Outline the string of lights and the ornament earrings with Black Lab.

STEP 6- Dip into clear glaze and fire to a cone 06.
