Hurricane Warning Party Ware

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

1034 Party Ware Salad Plate

FUN STROKES

FS-2300 Polar Bear
FS-2302 Orange Peel
FS-2303 Lime Ricky
FS-2305 Blue Heaven
FS-2314 Black Lab
FS-2315 What-a-Yolk
FS-2390 Orange Crush
FS-2392 Rockin Red

Step 1- Sponge Orange Peel to the center area of the plate with one light coat. Using a damp sponge, wipe off excess that got on the side area leading to the rim.

Step 2- Side load a round brush and shade the edge of the orange Peel with Orange Crush.

Step 3- Sponge the rim with 2 quick coats of Orange Crush.

Step 4- Trace pattern in the center of the plate.

Step 5- Fill 4 Fun Writer bottles, one with Lime Ricky, one with Polar Bear, What-a-Yolk and the other with Rockin Red. Start with the Rockin Red by applying to the bottom area of the hurricane glass. Fill in one coat pretty heavy. Apply the What-a-Yolk next by mixing a little into the red and coming up towards the center. Now do the same with the Polar Bear. Then the Lime Ricky last. The colors should blend into each other while still wet. Let this dry then apply the Polar Bear to the base and the top inside rim area. Let all of this dry before you apply the face and outline with Black Lab.

Step 6- Using Fun Writer bottles, apply a coat of Rockin Red to the hurricane flags. Apply Blue Heaven to the straw. Don't apply the Black Lab square in the center of the red flags until the red is good and dry.

Step 7- Using the Fun Writers, apply Rockin Red, Blue Heaven, Lime Ricky and What-a-Yolk to the rim to look like confetti. When dry, outline with Black lab. Do the thick line on the inside and outside of the rim also with the Black Lab.

Step 8- Apply a dot of Rockin Red and a dot of Lime Ricky to the letter I in the Hurricane Warning sign. Write the words with Black Lab. Clear glaze and fire to a cone 06.
