INGREDIENTS

Bisquefire #7049 Large Piggy Bank

Fun Strokes

FS- 2308 In The Pink
FS- 2314 Black Lab
FS- 2347 Lady Bug

Brushes & Other Materials

6500 Colorstix 1/4 inch Brush
6503 Colorstix # 4

Round Brush
6520 Colorstix 3/0
Detail Brush
Damp Paper Towel
Mirror

1700D or 9000D Clear Dipping Glaze

STEP 1- Wipe down the bisque with a damp sponge to remove dust. Apply 2 coats of In The Pink to the inside of the pigs ears with a # 4 brush.

STEP 2- Apply 2 coats of Black lab to the eyes and feet and one coat to make the eyebrows with a detail brush.

STEP 3- Using the quarter inch shader brush, dip into Lady Bug and apply to your lips. Like you would lipstick. Pucker your lips and kiss the pig where you want the lips to be. You will need to reload your lips for each set of lips you do. Wipe clean with the damp paper towel in between applying. Please Note: (Lady Bug is a food safe, non-toxic glaze that won't harm you in any way) If you prefer not to use your lips they do sell a lip stamp in the craft stores but it doesn't look as real.

STEP 4- Dip into 1700 or 9000 Clear Dipping Glaze and fire to cone 06.
