Sponge

Step 1- Trace pattern onto contact paper. Cut out pattern, peel off back and adhere to inside bottom of server. Be sure to rub down all edges.

Step 2- Use Mop brush to paint bottom and insides of server with 2-3 coats Prairie Gold. Let dry.

Step 3- Remove contact paper. Place pattern over flowers and trace in lines.

Step 4- Use brush #8 to paint flowers with 2-3 coats of Simply Cinnamon. Paint stems and leaves with Happy Go Lucky, 2-3 coats. Let dry.

Step 5- Use Fun Writer filled with Black Lab to create centers of flowers and outline petals. Outline one side of stems using a slightly broken line. Do the same for vines coming off stems and leaves. Let dry.

Step 6- Use Fun Writer filled with What a Yolk create yellow shoots coming from the black centers of flowers. Then draw lines to create highlights on the tops of the stems and the edges of leaves not traced in black. Let dry.

Step 7- With Mop brush apply 2-3 coats of River Stone around the rim of the server. Let dry. Flip over and paint bottom in the same manner. Let Dry.

Step 8- Use Fun Writer filled with Black Lab draw random curly lines around the perimeter of the server. Dot the 4 corners. Fire at cone 06
