

# Recipe of the Month!

## Decoupage Butterfly Frame

<b>Ingredients</b>	983-10 Ultimate Shader
<b>Bisquefire Item</b> #5002 Frame with Easel 5x7	
<b>Acrylic Stains</b> AS 6000 White	<b>Other</b> Gift tissue paper with pattern (butterflies used here)
<b>Specialty Products</b> AS 6047 No Fire Satin Matte	
<b>Brushes</b> 980-6 Ultimate Round Brush	

**STEP 1-** Sponge bisque frame to remove dust. Apply 1-2 coats of White to the entire frame. Allow to dry.

**STEP 2-** Rip tissue paper into small pieces. I tried to rip complete butterflies in each section. Let the pattern dictate how large the sections should be. Place all pieces in a pile.

**STEP 3-** Using the #10 Square Shader, apply a coat of No Fire Satin Matte to a small section at a time. Use the wet brush to pick up a section of tissue paper. Stick the tissue paper to the frame. Apply a second coat of No Fire Satin Matte over the tissue paper. Repeat and cover the entire frame with the tissue paper sections. Allow to dry.

**STEP 4-** Glue easel back to the frame.
