Flower Power Set

project time - 4 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

1029 FLARE WARE
CHARGER
2038 FLARE WARE MINI
BOWL

FUN STROKES

2300 POLAR BEAR
2305 BLUE HEAVEN
2314 BLACK LAB
2373 KEY LIME PIE
2374 BLUE ICE
2387 POOL PARTY

TOOLS

SIZE 4, 6 & 8 ROUND
BRUSH
1" GLAZE BRUSH
2373 KEY LIME PIE
FUN WRITER
COTTON T-SHIRT RAG
SYNTHETIC SPONGE

STEP 1 - To cone 04 bisque, apply 3 coats of Pool Party to the rim of the charger plate. Thoroughly soak your t-shirt rag and squeeze out the water, set aside. Using the glaze brush, soak the brush into the water and use some of drippings to water down your next color of Blue Ice. Quickly apply 1 thick coat of Blue Ice to one section of the rim (over the Pool Party color). Quickly pick up your rag, that is rolled up in the palm of your hand and firmly press with the rag to take some of that color out. The impression will become a two-tone ragged effect. Apply the same method to the rest of the rim, section by section and let dry. Using a dampened sponge, clean the inside portion of the platter, where some blue may have crossed onto. To the center of the charger, apply 2 generous coats of Polar Bear and let dry. Transfer pattern of the flowers onto the center.

STEP 2 - For the flowers, they all start with 2 coats of Black Lab centers, surrounded by 3 coats of Key Lime Pie. The outside flower portion can be painted with either 3 coats of Blue Heaven or Blue Ice. Refer to the photograph as a guide.

STEP 3 - For the stripes below, they consist of 3 coats of alternating colors of Key Lime Pie, Lime Light, Blue Ice and Blue Heaven. Finish off the charger with dots of Key Lime Pie using the Fun Writer.

THE DIP BOWL

STEP 1 - To cone 04 bisque, apply 3 coats of Pool Party to the outside of the mini flare bowl. Thoroughly soak your t-shirt rag and squeeze out the water, set aside. Using the glaze brush, soak the brush into the water and use some of drippings to water down your next color of Blue Ice. Quickly apply 1 thick coat of Blue Ice to one section of the outside of the bowl (over the Pool Party color). Quickly pick up your rag, that is rolled up in the palm of your hand and firmly press with the rag to take some of that color out. The impression will become a two-tone ragged effect. Use a dampened sponge to clean the inside portion of the bowl.

STEP 2 - Apply 2 generous coats of Polar Bear to the inside portion of the bowl and let dry thoroughly. Using a lead #2 pencil, free-hand draw the flower pattern to the inside of the bowl. Refer to the photograph as a guide. Start with the center and apply 2 generous coats of Black Lab, followed by 3 coats of Key Lime Pie, followed by 3 coats of Blue Ice. Accent the rest of the inside of the bowl with dots of Key Lime Pie with the Fun Writer. Dip into clear glaze and fire to cone 06.

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
