# Football Platter

project time -2-4 hours



## INGREDIENTS

### BISQUEFIRE

3035 Oval Rim Bread Platter  
2032 Tall Cereal Bowl

### FUN STROKES

FS-2300 Polar Bear  
FS-2313 Happy Trails  
FS-2327 Blazing Saddles  
FS-2329 Hi Ho Silver  
FS-2341 Kermit  
FS-2381 BeBoppin Blue  
FS-2392 Rockin Red

**Note:** This project can be used for any football team. Logos for teams are available on-line.

**STEP 1-** Apply 3 coats of Kermit to the center area of the platter. Apply 3 coats of Blue-by-U to the rim and the backside of the platter.

**STEP 2-** Apply 3 to 4 coats of Blazing Saddles to the entire bowl. Trace pattern onto platter and bowl. When tracing the logo in the center of the field, only trace the outer edge of the logo at this time.

**STEP 3-** Apply 2 coats of Hi Ho Silver mixed with a little Polar Bear to make a light gray and apply to the face area of the patriot logo.

**STEP 4-** Fill three Fun Writer bottles, one with Polar Bear, one with Rockin Red and one with Blue-by-U. From the fun writer bottles, apply Polar Bear to the lines and numbers on the field. Apply one coat to the entire logo in the center of the field. Let dry. Trace the rest of the logo onto the white.

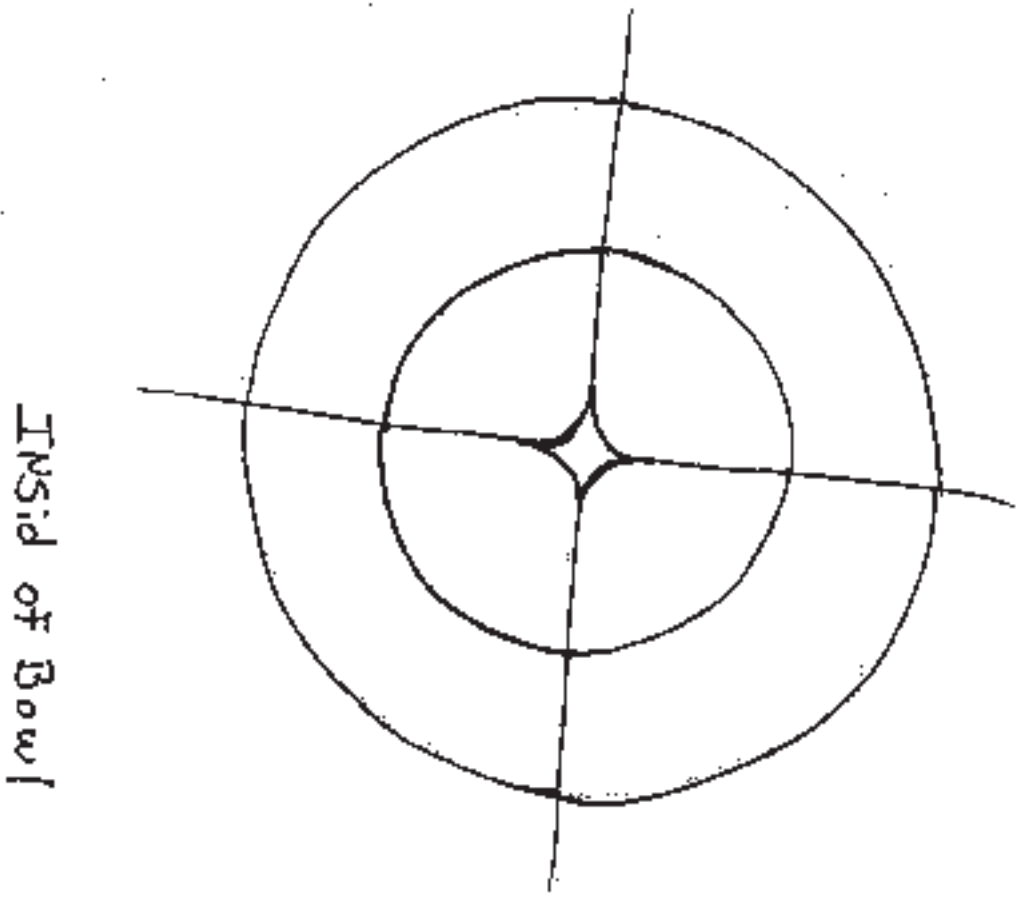
**STEP 5-** Apply Rockin Red to the letters New England and to the red area of the Patriot logo. Apply BeBoppin Blue to the blue area of the logo going around the stars that remain white. See photo.

**STEP 6-** Apply Polar Bear from the Fun Writer bottle to the word Patriot and the star on the rim.

**STEP 7-** Apply Polar Bear from the Fun Writer bottle to the white stripe in the center and to the stitching. Apply one coat of Happy Trails with a brush or from a Fun Writer bottle to the rest of the lines on the bowl. Dip into clear glaze and fire to a shelf cone 06.
