INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

1-5002 5X7 FRAME

FUN STROKES

2300 POLAR BEAR

2309 RED ROVER

2314 BLACK LAB

2341 KERMIT

2347 LADY BUG

2366 CHOCOLATE MOOSE

2373 KEY LIME PIE

2383 MELLOW YELLOW

TOOLS

5X7 CHALKBOARD &

CHALK

DETAIL BRUSH

SIZE 4 ROUND BRUSH

SIZE 6 ROUND BRUSH

SIZE 8 ROUND BRUSH

EPOXY GLUE

STEP 1 - Transfer pattern #1 onto the frame. Starting from the top, apply 2 generous coats of Black Lab to the top (refer to the photograph as a guide). For the next line, apply 3 coats of Mellow Yellow and let dry. Make small Black Lab Fun Writer stripes along the Mellow Yellow line and let dry. Apply 3 to 4 generous coats of Lady Bug for the next line. Apply 3 coats of Mellow Yellow for the sides of the frame. Near the bottom, apply 2 generous coats of Black Lab and 3 to 4 generous coats of Lady Bug for the next line. For the checkerboard pattern, start with 2 generous coats of Polar Bear squares and let dry. Fill in the rest of the square with 2 generous coats of Black Lab.

STEP 2 - Transfer pattern #2 onto the sides of the frame for the cherries and leaves application. For the leaves, apply 3 coats of Key Lime Pie for the leaves and let dry. For the cherries, apply 3 to 4 coats of Lady Bug. Highlight the outer edge of the cherries with Red Rover. Highlight the outer edge of the leaves with Kermit with a small line in the middle of the leaf as well with Kermit. Using a detail brush, paint a small scoop of Black Lab to accentuate the dip in the cherry stem. (refer to the photograph as a guide) Using the detail brush, apply 1 coat of Chocolate Moose for the cherry stem.

STEP 3 - Apply Black Lab Fun Writer dots to the sides of the Mellow Yellow. Using the same Fun Writer detail the words, "Home Sweet Home" on top of the Lady Bug portion at the top. Using a detail brush or the Black Lab Fun Writer, apply a thin line that separates the Lady Bug and Mellow Yellow line. Using the Polar Bear Fun Writer, apply small polka dots to the top of the Black Lab portion. Apply 2 generous coats of Black Lab to the sides of the frame to finish off the ends. Dip the frame into clear glaze and fire to cone 06. When cooled, attach the chalkboard to the back of the frame and let dry thoroughly. Attach a small ribbon loop if you want to hang the chalkboard. For a free-standing chalkboard, attach the frame backing to the back of the chalkboard.
