	INGREDIENTS	TOOLS
	BISQUEFIRE 5007 MESSAGE FRAME	DETAIL BRUSH SIZE 4 ROUND BRUSH SIZE 12 ROUND BRUSH STICK ON APPLIQUES MASKING TAPE EPOXY GLUE
	FUN STROKES 2300 POLAR BEAR 2306 BLUE-BY-U 2315 WHAT A YOLK OR CHOOSE YOUR OWN SCHOOL or COLLEGE COLORS	

STEP 1 - On a cone 04 bisque frame, tape off the right side of the message frame which is where the state name will go. Transfer the pennant pattern to the top left-hand corner of the frame for the school year.

STEP 2 - Apply 2 generous coats of Polar Bear, using a size 12 round brush to the frame (refer to the photograph as your guide) and let dry. Apply 3 coats of What a Yolk for the pennant, using a size 4 round brush. Remove the tape from the right side of the frame and apply 3 coats of What a Yolk to that empty section. Let dry completely. Using a size 4 round brush, apply Blue-By-U to the inside of the message frame (refer to the photograph as a guide) Using a detail brush, outline the pennant with Blue-By-U and detail in the school year. Using the detail brush with Blue-By-U, apply that color for the state name on the right side over the What A Yolk and a straight line to separate the Polar Bear and What A Yolk color.

STEP 3 - After the frame is completely dry, dip into clear glaze and fire to cone 06. After the frame is cooled off, epoxy the backing of the frame and let dry. Attach the applications to the frame.
