Pastel Heart Plate

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

3009 Heart Plate

FUN STROKES

FS 2308- In The Pink

FS 2321 Berry Nice

FS 2323- Jumpin Juniper

FS 2337- Lil Boy Blue

FS 2373- Key Lime Pie

FS 2375- Jumpin Jelly

STEP 1- Apply 2 thin coats of Polar Bear to the whole top side of the plate. Trace pattern.

STEP 2- All colors except the black outline are done with a watercolor technique. Put some Jumpin Jelly, In The Pink, Jumpin Juniper, Lil Boy Blue and Key Lime Pie on a tile. Apply one thin coat (watered down slightly) to the hearts and stripes on the edge. These don't need to be in any special order. Just alternate colors so it looks nice.

STEP 3- Load a #4 round brush, dip into water, dab off on a paper towel just once so there is still some water in your brush. Now slide a side of the round brush down the edge of one color at a time and apply to the inside edge of each heart so that you will be making the heart darker at the edges. The color side of the brush should be closest to the heart edge and the water edge should move gradually towards the center. Do this with a light touch so you don't pull up the color beneath it.

STEP 4- Wet, dab and slide side three of the colors where the heart center meets the rimmed edge. In The Pink, Something Blue and Key Lime Pie.

STEP 5- Dip into clear glaze and fire to a cone 06.

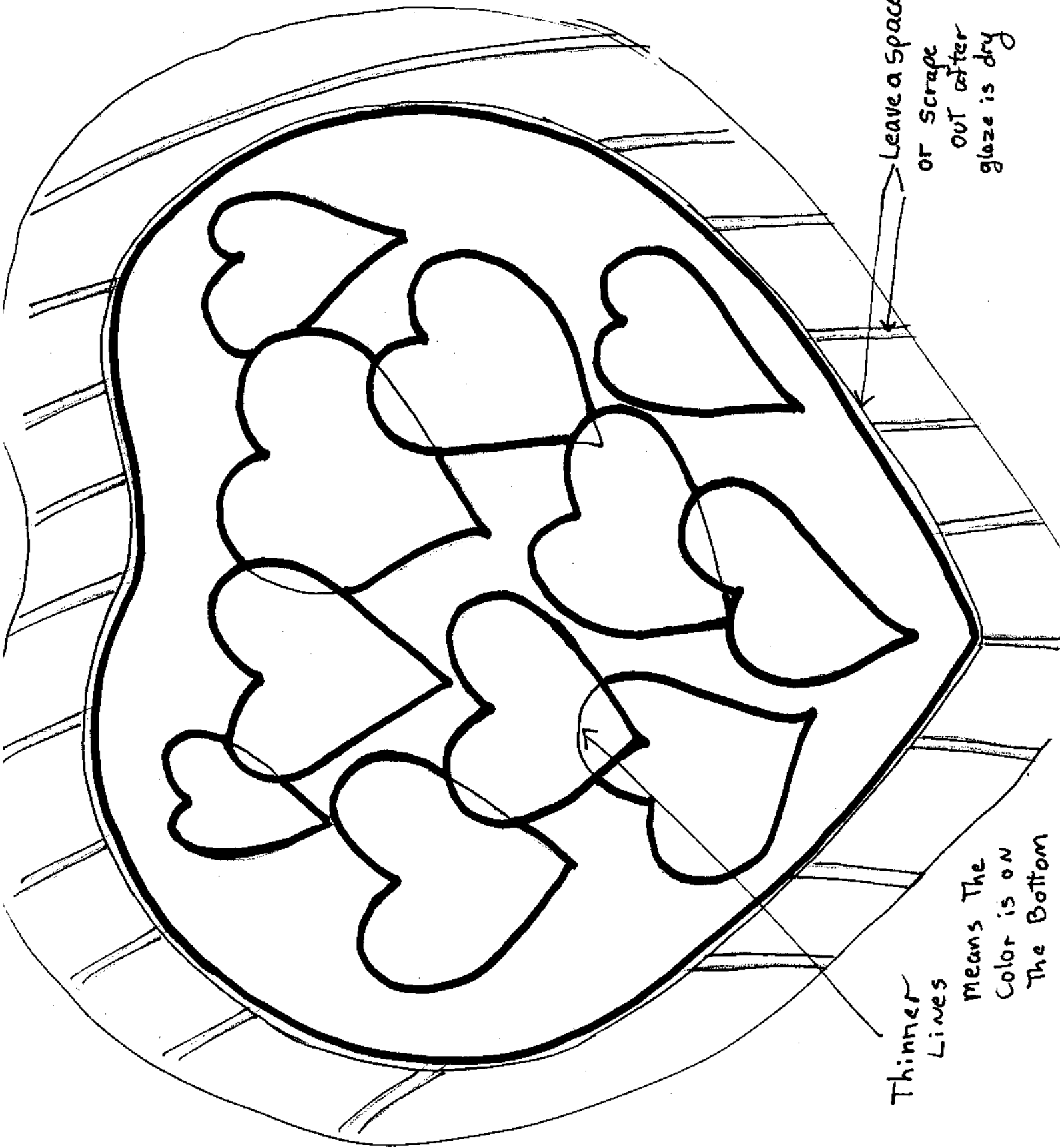
