SYNTHETIC SPONGE

**STEP 1** - To cone 04 bisque, wet your sponge and keep a small amount of water to dip into Pool Party to water down the color and lightly apply for the sky of the platter. Using the same technique, apply one coat of Double Mint to the left side of the platter for the water. Use the same technique again to apply one coat of Tweety Bird for the sand. Refer to the photograph as a guide. Let dry thoroughly. Transfer the pattern onto the platter.

**STEP 2** - Starting with the palm trees and palm leaves silhouettes, apply 3 coats of Blue Heaven. For the female, apply 3 coats of Tickled Pink for the top and skirt. Apply 3 coats of Old Yeller for the hair and 2 to 3 coats of Pumpkin Pie for the skin. Apply 2 coats of Lime Light at the top of her skirt. Refer to the photograph as a guide. Apply dots to the top using the Polar Bear Fun Writer.

**STEP 3** - For the male figure, apply 3 coats of Old Yeller for the hat. Apply 3 coats of Sammy Salmon for the shirt. Apply 2 coats of Sweet Pea for the shorts. Apply 3 coats of Pumpkin Pie. For the border, apply 3 coats of Sammy Salmon. Dip into clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
