## Jellybean Mug

### INGREDIENTS

#### Fun Strokes

FS 2300 Polar Bear  
FS 2303 Lime Ricky  
FS 2305 Blue Heaven  
FS 2315 What a Yolk  
FS 2319 This Li'l Piggy  
FS 2335 Tickled Pink  
FS 2336 Wineona

1700D or 9000D Clear Dipping Glaze

#### Brushes

980-6 & 8 Round  
984-2/0 Liner  
987 Square Shader

**STEP 1-** Apply 3 coats of What a Yolk to the inside of the mug. Using a sponge and What a Yolk, sponge around to the outside edge of the mug just over the rim.

**STEP 2-** Squeeze out on a palette about a quarter size amount of the following colors: Lime Ricky, Blue Heaven, What a Yolk, Wineona, In The Pink and This Li'l Piggy. Using a # 6 round brush, apply all the different color jellybeans with a comma stroke. Put a highlight in each jellybean using Polar Bear.

**NOTE:** This is where you should count the jellybeans. If you lose track, you can count them by using a pencil mark on each one that will fire off when it's fired. Paint the # of jelly beans on the bottom.

**STEP 3-** Apply 3 coats of Wineona to the handle of the mug. Dip into Clear Dipping Glaze. Fire to a shelf cone 06.
