Kids Plate

INGREDIENTS

Bisquefire plate

#1001 Rim Salad Plate

Fun Strokes

FS-2303 Lime Ricky

FS-2311 The Color Purple

FS-2315 What-a-Yolk

FS-2319 This Li'l Piggy

FS-2354 Something Blue

Bumpy Doodles

BD-2500 Bumpy Snow

BD-2501 Bumpy Banana

BD-2503 Bumpy Berry

BD-2504 Bumpy Blue

1700D or 9000D Clear

Dipping Glaze

STEP 1- Trace pattern onto plate. Trace all the lines on the rim. You will be doing the whole rim with the blue and green then going over those colors with the heart, star and flower.

STEP 2- Using a small sponge, apply one coat of Lime Ricky and Something Blue to the squares while alternating colors. Retrace the pattern of where the star, heart and flower go if you need to.

STEP 3- Apply 3 coats of This Li'l Piggy to the heart. Apply 3 coats of What-a-Yolk to the star and apply 3 coats of The Color Purple to the flower.

STEP 4- Apply Bumpy Snow to outline the squares on the rim. Make the lines zig-zag and broken. Apply the Bumpy Snow also on the inside edge of the heart, star and flower as a stitch line. Apply Bumpy Banana to the flower center and the zig-zag in the heart. Apply Bumpy Berry to the outside of the star, heart and flower but leave a small space going about a quarter inch from the edge. Refer to photo. Apply dots of Bumpy Blue to the trail going through the plate and also for the child's name in the heart.

STEP 5- Dip into 1700 or 900 Clear Dipping Glaze and fire to a cone 06.
