# Stringing up the Lights

## Ingredients:

### Fun Strokes

FS 2301 Smiley Face  
FS 2303 Lime Ricky  
FS 2305 Blue Heaven  
FS 2314 Black Lab  
FS 2329 Hi Ho Silver  
FS 2345 Goldfish  
FS 2347 Lady Bug

## Brushes

#4 Fan Brush  
740-2, 4, 6 Drybrushes  
980-4, 8 Ultimate Round  
Brush  
981-1 Ultimate Liner  
983-10 Shader Brush

## Bumpy Doodles

BD 2500 Bumpy Snow

## Glaze

GG 1700D Clear Dipping  
Glaze  
Or NTG 9000D Simplicity  
Dipping Glaze

**STEP 1-** Sponge ware to remove dust. Trace the light bulb pattern several times onto contact paper. Peel and stick the bulbs to the top of the plate.

**STEP 2-** Apply 2 coats of Black Lab around the bulbs to the entire front and back of the plate. Allow to dry, then peel the bulbs from the plate.

**STEP 3-** Lightly mark with a pencil the colors of each bulb. Apply 4 coats of the following colors to the bulbs. Blue Heaven, Lime Ricky, Smiley Face, Goldfish, Ladybug. Apply 3 coats of Hi Ho Silver to the base section of each bulb. Allow each coat to dry slightly before applying the next.

**STEP 4-** Lightly sketch or trace the spiral lines on the bulb bases. Corner load a square brush with Black Lab. Shade a thin stripe under each traced line. Repeat to all lines. It is best to start at the top and work your way down.

**STEP 5-** Corner load a square brush with Black Lab, shade one side of all bulbs.

**STEP 6-** Squeeze a small amount of Bumpy Doodles out onto a tile or palette. Apply a raised coat of Bumpy Snow to the highlight section opposite the shadow.

**STEP 7-** Dip into GG1700 or NTG 9000 Clear Dipping Glaze. Fire to shelf cone 06.
