# Martini Pitcher & Glass

## INGREDIENTS

### BISQUEFIRE

4017 ICE TEA  
PITCHER  
4041 MARTINI  
GLASS

## TOOLS

Contact Paper  
FUNWRITER filled  
with Polar Bear  
Pencil  
Size 6 Round Brush  
Size 4 Round Brush

## FUN STROKES

2300 POLAR BEAR  
2303 LIME RICKY  
2314 BLACK LAB  
2347 LADY BUG  
2373 KEY LIME PIE

**STEP 1** - Cut out 12 olive shapes from the contact paper. Cut a 1" strip from the contact paper also. Apply the olive shapes in scattered areas on the pitcher and glass (refer to photograph as a guide) Apply the 1" strip of contact paper to the pitcher, 1/2" from the very bottom. Apply 2 -3 coats of Lime Ricky to the inside of the martini glass and pitcher. Apply 2 generous coats of Polar Bear to the handle of the pitcher and to the bottom stem of the glass and let dry. Apply 2 generous coats of Black Lab to the pitcher and the martini glass.(refer to photograph as a guide).

**STEP 2** - For the handle of the pitcher and the stem of the glass, apply 2 to 3 coats of Black Lab in a swirled stripe formation. Remove the contact paper and finger sand lightly on any rough areas surrounding the olives or where the strip was. Apply 3 coats of Lime Ricky for the band on the bottom of the pitcher and all the olives on both pieces. Shade one side of the olive with 2 coats of Key Lime Pie. Add 3 coats of Lady Bug circles for the top part of the olives on both pieces and let dry.

**STEP 3** - Using the Funwriter, filled with Polar Bear apply dots in a scattered formation on the pitcher and the glass.(refer to photograph as a guide) Also use the Funwriter to write "MARTINI". Apply clear glaze and fire to cone 06.

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
