INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

5002 5x7 Frame

FUNSTROKES

2300 Polar Bear

2306 Blue-By-U

2308 In the Pink

2341 Kermit

2368 Old Yeller

2380 Gosh Garnet

Gloss Glaze

1700D or 9000D

Clear Dipping Glaze

TOOLS

Sponge

Liner Brush

#6 Round Brush

Erasable Memo Board

STEP 1 - Transfer pattern onto cone 04 bisque frame. Starting with the heart corners, apply 3 coats of In the Pink. Using a liner brush, apply Polar Bear in a criss cross manner over the Pink as photographed. Let dry. Using a liner brush, apply 2 -3 coats of Gosh Garnet to paint the heart design and finish the remaining corner with dots of Gosh Garnet.

STEP 2 - For the top and bottom yellow section, apply 2 coats of Old Yeller, using a sponge and let dry. For the left and right side, blue section, sponge long streaks of Blue-by-U to cover the sides. Using the same sponge, apply a little bit of Kermit to help accentuate that section. Using a liner brush, apply Old Yeller swirls to the sides. See photograph.

STEP 3 - Using a #6 round brush, apply Blue-by-U to the inside and outside rim of the frame. After the glaze firing, attach the memo board to the back of the frame and attach a ribbon in order to hang the board on the wall.

STEP 4- Dip into Clear Dipping Glaze and fire to a shelf cone 06.
