Name Frame

INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

1-5001 FRAME
BROKEN BISQUE
CHIPS

FUN STROKES

2318 THE NAKED
TRUTH
2343 PEACHY KEEN
2388 PEACH FUZZ
2389 SAMMY SALMON

TOOLS

POLAR BEAR FUN-
WRITER
SIZE 4 ROUND BRUSH
SIZE 6 ROUND BRUSH
SIZE 8 ROUND BRUSH
FLAT IRIDESCENT
MARBLES
CONTACT PAPER
EPOXY GLUE

STEP 1 - Cut out 8 to 10 contact paper squares or rectangles and place them onto the cone 04 bisque frame in any order that seems right for you. Apply 3 coats of Peach Fuzz to the entire frame and let dry thoroughly. Gently remove half of the contact squares and apply 3 coats of Peachy Keen to those squares and let dry. Gently remove the rest of the contact paper squares and apply 3 coats of Sammy Salmon.

STEP 2 - Outline a few squares with the Polar Bear Fun Writer to accentuate and highlight the squares a little. Draw a thin border of the frame with the Polar Bear Fun Writer and place a few dots scattered around.

STEP 3 - According to the person's name, apply 3 coats of The Naked Truth to base coat the broken bisque chips. Outline the edging of the chips with Sammy Salmon of 3 coats and let dry. Dip the frame into clear glaze. Brush clear glaze onto the bisque chips and let dry. Fire all your pieces to cone 06 firing. When the pieces have cooled down, attach the name chips with epoxy along with the flat marbles (refer to the photograph as your guide) Attach the frame backing with epoxy glue and let dry.
