# Mixing Popcorn Bowl

project time - 2 hours



## INGREDIENTS

### BISQUEFIRE

Bisquefire # 2010 Mixing Bowl

### Fun Strokes

FS-2300 Polar Bear

FS-2314 Black Lab

FS-2368 Old Yeller

FS-2392 Rockin Red

### Brushes and other Materials

# 6 Round

Fun Writer Bottle or Detail Brush

Synthetic Sponge

**Step 1-** (Because of taping) Don't wash down the bisque with a wet sponge. Use a dry sponge just to get the dust off. Use masking tape to do the stripes on the side. If you tip the bowl upside down and take one piece of tape and go directly across the bottom center so that the stripe goes on both sides. When you do the second piece of tape go across the other way so now you have a plus sign on the bottom, then go across diagonally Twice so your making an X. Turn the bowl upright and take the tape around the rim.

**Step 2-** Apply 3 coats of Rockin Red to the stripes that are not covered. Peel off the tape when dry then clean up the edges of the stripes.

**Step 3-** Clean the inside of the bowl with a damp sponge so the red stripes only come on the top rim of the bowl. Squeeze out some Old Yeller onto a tile. Dap a sponge into water, squeeze out some of the water but leave enough water in the sponge so that it is more wet than damp. Dap the sponge into some Old Yeller and sponge the inside of the bowl very lightly.

**Step 4-** Fill a Fun Writer bottle with Rockin Red and write The (your name) Family Popcorn Bowl across the top inside edge as shown in photo.

**Step 5-** Using a # 10 or 12 round brush, apply three circles of white for all the popcorn. Apply heavy and in a swoosh type of stroke.

**Step 6-** Fill a Fun Writer Bottle with Black lab and outline the popcorn.

**Step 7-** Dip into Clear Glaze and fire to a cone 06.

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
