Petal Popcorn Bowl

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

Bisquefire # 2013 Petal Serving Bowl

Fun Strokes

FS-2300 Polar Bear
FS-2303 Lime Ricky
FS-2305 Blue Heaven
FS-2314 Black Lab
FS-2315 What-a-Yolk
FS-2368 Old Yeller
FS-2375 Jumpin Jelly
FS-2392 Rockin Red

Brushes and other materials

4 & 8 Round Brush
Sponges
One Fun Writer Bottle or Detail Brush

Step 1- In the center of the bowl at the bottom is a large popcorn. I did this by sponging three big uneven circles with Polar Bear. I then dab some Old Yeller onto my sponge and lightly dabbed it on some of the white to represent butter. I then side loaded a # 6 round brush and shaded some Old Yeller on the outside edges of the popcorn.

Step 2- I wrote I love (heart) Popcorn three times on the inside alternating the following colors: Blue Heaven, Jumpin Jelly, Lime Ricky, What-a-Yolk and Rockin Red. See photo. I used the same colors for the small dots going around the inside edge alternating about every 14 dots.

Step 3- Cut out different size circles from sponges and sponge on circles using the same colors in step 2. Overlap some of the circles.

Step 4- Sponge Rocking Red to the rim of the bowl. Outline all the letters with Black Lab using a Fun Writer or a detail brush.

Step 5- Dip into Clear glaze and fire to a cone 06.
