Square Popcorn Bowl

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

2015 Large Square Bowl

Fun Strokes

FS-2300 Polar Bear

FS-2314 Black Lab

FS-2315 What-a-Yolk

FS-2381 Be Boppin Blue

Brushes and other materials

4 & 12 Round Brush

Sponge

3 Fun Writer Bottles or Detail Brush

Step 1- (Because of taping) Don't wash down the bisque with a wet sponge. Use a dry sponge just to get the dust off. Use masking tape to do the stripes on the side. Space them about an inch apart going around the whole bowl.

Step 2- Apply 3 coats of Be-boppin Blue to the stripes that are not covered. Peel off the tape when dry then clean up the edges of the stripes.

Step 3- Apply 2 to 3 coats of Black Lab to the inside of the bowl going around the edge to the outside about a half-inch.

Step 4- Let dry- Trace pattern to the inside. I only have it on one side of the bowl.

Step 5- Fill 3 Fun Writer bottles with these colors-one with What-a-Yolk, one with Polar Bear and one with Rockin Red. By using these you will only need one coat even over the black.

Step 6- Use the polar Bear Fun Writer to apply all the popcorn on the inside of the bowl. Scatter them around, not too many because you need to fit in the words Popcorn. and to the top part of the movie action board. Apply Rockin Red with the Fun Writer to the bottom part of the movie action board. Write your favorite movie in the bottom white area as shown on photo. Write "Movie Time" with the What-a-Yolk Fun Writer. On the inside. Also using the Fun Writer apply the words "popcorn" scattered around the inside as shown in photo.

Step 7- Apply the words popcorn down the blue stripes on the outside of the bowl. With the Polar Bear. Apply one line of Be Boppin Blue to the stripe down the center of the white area between the popcorn stripes using a liner brush.

Step 8- Dip and fire to a cone 06.
