Stacking Popcorn Bowl

project time - 2 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

2046 10" Stacking Bowl

Fun Strokes

FS-2300 Polar Bear
FS-2314 Black Lab
FS-2337 Lil Boy Blue
FS-2368 Old Yeller
FS-2392 Rockin Red

Brushes and other Materials

6 Round
2 Fun Writer Bottles or Detail Brush
Synthetic Sponge

Step 1- Wipe down the bisque with a damp sponge. Squeeze out some Old Yeller onto a tile. Dab a sponge into the Old Yeller with lots of water. Sponge the inside of the bowl and the rim very lightly. One thin watered down coat. Now add some Old Yeller to the sponge and drip down the inside of the bowl to look like melted butter. Don't go overboard. Clean up the bottom of the bowl on the outside.

Step 2- Trace pattern of the ticket and the word POPCORN to the outside of the rim. Apply two coats of Lil Boy Blue to the ticket. Squeeze out some Polar Bear on a tile. Using a # 10 or 12 round brush, apply three circles of white for all the popcorn. Apply heavy and in a swoosh type of stroke.

Step 3- Fill 2 Fun Writer bottles, one with Rockin Red and one with Black Lab. Apply the Rockin Red to the letters POPCORN and outline only the popcorn pieces that are in the lettering representing the "O". Also write small "pop" and "popcorn" around the outside rim between the popcorn pieces.

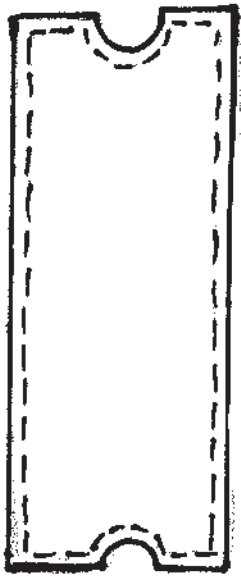
Step 4- using the Black Lab Fun Writer, outline all the popcorn. Do this in an uneven way. Don't try and outline perfect. It should be done as shown in photo. Also write in a name on the ticket.

Step 5- Turn the bowl upside down and apply 3 to 4 coats of Rockin Red to the bottom part of the bowl.

Step 6- Dip into Clear Glaze and fire to a cone 06.

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
