Pumpkin Trio

INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

2025 3 CIRCLE BOWL
FUN STROKES
2300 POLAR BEAR
2301 SMILEY FACE
2304 GREEN ACRES
2314 BLACK LAB
2326 FIR EVER GREEN
2373 KEY LIME PIE
2374 BLUE ICE
2390 ORANGE CRUSH
2392 ROCKIN' RED

TOOLS

CONTACT PAPER
LEAD #2 PENCIL
DETAIL BRUSH
SIZE 4, 6, 8 & 12
ROUND BRUSH
POLAR BEAR FUN
WRITER

STEP 1 - Cut out of contact paper, eyes, nose and mouth for each bowl section and apply for each section firmly. Apply 3 coats of Orange Crush for the inside sections of the bowl and let dry. Try to leave a small wavy section that will be painted later for the tops of the pumpkins. Carefully remove the contact paper eyes, noses and mouths. Apply 3 coats of Smiley Face for the eyes, noses and mouths. Fill in the middle bowl mouth with Rockin' Red. Apply 2 coats of Polar Bear for the eyes of the middle bowl. Apply 2 coats of Blue Ice for the pupil and 1 coat of Black Lab for the iris. Using a detail brush, make eyelashes for the eyes. Shade the red lips with Black Lab. Shade the rest of the eyes, noses and mouths with Black Lab. Using the lead pencil, draw lines for the pumpkin grooves. Shade the grooves with Black Lab.

STEP 2 - Apply 3 coats of Key Lime Pie for the green pumpkin tops and let dry. Carefully draw stems for each top. Shade each stems with Fir Ever Green and add thin lines around the stems for ivy.

STEP 3 - Apply 2 to 3 coats of Black Lab to the outside of the bowl and let dry. Using the Polar Bear Fun Writer, write the words, "Boo", "trick or treat", etc. and dots. Dip into clear glaze and fire to cone 06.
