# Rim Bowls

project time -2-4 hours



## INGREDIENTS

### BISQUEFIRE

2057, 2058 & 2059 Rim Bowls

### FUN STROKES

FS- 2314 Black Lab

FS- 2315 What-a-Yolk

FS- 2305 Blue Heaven

FS- 2373 Key Lime Pie

FS- 2390 Orange Crush

FS- 2391 Red Blaze

FS- 2392 Rockin Red

**STEP 1- Large Bowl:** Apply 3 coats of Blue Heaven to the bottom part of the large bowl. Apply 3 coats of Key Lime Pie to the inside of the large bowl. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the rim of the bowl. Using a Fun Writer filled with Rockin Red, apply a red trim on the outer edge of the rim as shown in the photo.

**STEP 2- Medium Bowl:** Apply 3 coats of Red Blaze to the outside of the bowl. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the inside of the bowl and bring it up onto the rim. Go also on the rim edge.

**STEP 3-** Fill 6 fun writer bottles. Apply 1 to 2 coats from the fun writer bottle on top of the Black Lab. Leave a space between each color so the Black Lab will look like an outline. One coat from a fun writer bottle is usually sufficient but seeing the rim is at a slight angle, you are better off to apply two thinner coats rather than one heavy coat. If it's applied too heavy it will flow down into the bowl before it has time to dry. Once it is dry it will stay put during the firing. Don't bring the colors over the edge, just to the edge. The colors are in order here like they are placed on the bowl. Also check the pattern. I started with Rockin Red, Blue Heaven, Key Lime Pie, What-a-Yolk, Orange Crush and Red Blaze.

**STEP 4- Small Bowl:** Apply 3 coats of What-a-Yolk to the bottom side of the bowl. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the inside of the bowl and bring it up onto the rim. Go also on the rim edge. Using the same fun writer colors, start a spiral from the center bottom of the bowl connecting each color. Start with Rockin Red to Red Blaze to Orange Crush to What-a-Yolk to Key Lime Pie to Blue Heaven the as your nearing the top of the bowl switch back to Rockin Red. Bring the red right up on the rim and cover the rim just leaving the black on the edges and one space as show in photo. Dip into Clear Glaze and fire to a shelf cone 06.
