# Snowman Mug

**Ingredients:** 1700D or 9000D Clear Dipping Glaze

**Bisquefire**  
#4004 Cone/Flare Mug

**Fun Strokes**  
FS 2303 Lime Ricky  
FS 2304 Green Acres  
FS 2306 Blue by U  
FS 2314 Black Lab  
FS 2328 Mocha-Chino  
FS 2345 Goldfish  
FS 2354 Something Blue  
FS 2371 Coffee-n-Cream

**Bumpy Doodles**  
BD 2500 Bumpy Snow

**Brushes**  
#4 Fan Brush  
740-2, 4, 6 Drybrushes  
980-4, 8 Ultimate Round Brush  
981-1 Ultimate Liner  
983-10 Shader Brush

**STEP 1-** Sponge on 2 coats of Something Blue to the handle and the outside of the mug going into the inside about a quarter of an inch.

**STEP 2-** Trace outline of pattern to the front of the mug.

**STEP 3-** Squeeze out some Bumpy Snow onto a tile. Using a damp sponge, apply two coats to the snowman's body and head. Also sponge some Bumpy Snow on the bottom area of the mug to put snow on the ground.

**STEP 4-** When the Bumpy Snow is completely dry, trace or sketch the rest of the pattern.

**STEP 5-** Shade around the arms and hand area to define them using Something Blue.

**STEP 6-** Apply a coat of Green Acres to the scarf. Apply 2 coats of Goldfish to the carrot nose and to the carrot sticks. Apply a little Lime Ricky for the tops of the carrot sticks. Apply Mocha Chino to the buttons. Apply two coats of Coffee-n-Cream to the bird and the bunny. Apply 1 very light coat of Blue by U to the eyes. Using Black Lab and a small detail brush, apply pupils and detail to eyes, nose, mouth, buttons, bird and bunny.

**STEP 7-** Using Bumpy Snow and a small detail brush, draw on snowflakes sporadically around the mug. Apply the remaining snowflakes with dots from the Bumpy Doodle bottle.

**STEP 8-** Dip into Clear Dipping Glaze. Fire to a shelf cone 06.

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
