Stacking Bowls

project time -2-4 hours



INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

2039 - 6" Stacking
Bowls

FUN STROKES

FS- 2300 Polar Bear
FS- 2303 Lime Ricky
FS- 2314 Black Lab
FS- 2318 The Naked
Truth
FS- 2368 Old Yeller

FS- 2370 Buck Naked
FS- 2372 Mocha Fudge
FS- 2392 Rockin Red
FS- 2408 Bananarama
FS- 2410 Blizzard Blue
FS- 2414 Lizard Lime
FS- 2416 Funfetti

Special Notes: Refer to pattern for bowls # 1,2,3 & 4. To bowl # 1 (bottom). Each bowl has vertical dots on the rim to line up each bowl correctly.

STEP 1- To bowl # 1 (bottom bowl) Trace pattern of the pants to the rim of the bowl. Don't trace the diamonds yet. Apply 3 coats of Bananarama to the bottom outside of the bowl. Apply 3 coats of Blizzard Blue to the pants. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the inside and the rim of the bowl going around the pants. Trace the rest of the pattern, the diamonds and the feet. Apply 2 coats of Rockin Red to the diamonds using the Fun Writer bottle. If you use a brush to apply the red over the black it will require about four coats. By applying the color from a fun writer bottle, it will only require 1 to 2 coats. Apply legs with Black Lab and feet with Mocha Fudge.

STEP 2- Bowl # 2. Trace pattern of the shirt to the rim of the bowl. Don't trace the dots yet. Apply 3 coats of Rockin Red to the bottom of the bowl. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the inside of the bowl and the rim going around the shirts. Fill a Fun Writer bottle with Rockin Red and apply 3 dots between each shirt. Don't forget to put a line of dots so that you will be able to line them up correctly after they are fired.

STEP 3- Bowl # 3. Trace pattern of the heads to the rim of the bowl. Don't trace the arms, Ice cream cones or the facial features yet. Apply 3 coats of The Naked Truth to the heads. Add a little hair using Old Yeller and Mocha Fudge. Apply 3 coats of Lizard Lime to the bottom of the bowl. Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the inside of the bowl and the rim going around the heads. Fill a Fun Writer bottle with Black Lab, one with Buck Naked and one with Polar Bear. Apply arms with the Polar Bear. Apply the faces with Black Lab and apply the cones with Buck Naked. Don't forget to add the line of red dots so that you will be able to line them up correctly after they are fired.

STEP 4- Bowl # 4. The red line up dot on this top bowl is the cherry that is on top of the ice cream where as all the other cherries are off to the side. Don't trace any of the pattern onto this bowl yet. Apply 3 of Lime Ricky to the inside of the bowl. Apply 3 coats of Blizzard Blue to the outside bottom part of the bowl and apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the rim of the bowl. Now you can trace the pattern onto the rim. Apply 2 to 3 good coats of Funfetti to the ice cream. Apply the Buck Naked from the Fun Writer bottle to the cones. Using a Fun Writer filled with Mocha Fudge apply the lines on the cones on this bowl and the # 3 bowl with the other part of the cones. Apply the cherry on each ice cream with Rockin Red. Also write Ice Cream in Rockin Red, Old Yeller and Lime Ricky between cones. Remember that one of the cherries is on the top of the ice cream instead of the side for the line up of the bowls. Dip into clear glaze and fire to a cone 06.

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
