INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

Large round box # 7105,
Medium round box
7104, Small round box
7103 and top with Rim
tea light # 5013

FUN STROKES

FS- 2300 Polar Bear
FS- 2314 Black Lab
FS- 2319 This Li'l Piggy
FS- 2329 Hi Ho Silver
FS- 2341 Kermit
FS- 2374 Blue Ice
FS- 2375 Jumpin' Jelly
FS- 2381 Be Boppin'
Blue

FS- 2390 Orange Crush

FS- 2392 Rockin' Red

BRUSHES

Colorstix # 12 and 6
Round
Colorstix # 3/0 Detail

MISCELLANEOUS

Synthetic Sponge
Fun Writer Bottle

STEP 1- Apply 2 coats of Polar Bear to all three boxes and lids using a #12 round brush or you can sponge on the color.

STEP 2- Trace Pattern to each box. Sponge 2 coats of Blue Heaven the medium lid and down onto the scarf area of the other two boxes as shown in photo. Also apply to the band on the hat (tea light votive). Shade with Be Boppin Blue.

STEP 3- Apply 3 coats of Rockin' Red to the mittens. Apply 2 coats of Orange Crush to the nose. One very light coat of This Li'l Piggy to the cheeks. 2 coats of Kermit to the top button, 2 coats of Blue Ice to the middle button and 2 coats of Jumpin Jelly to the bottom button.

STEP 4- Apply 2 coats of Black lab to the hat going around the band. Outline the buttons, mittens and face with Black lab also.

STEP 5- Using a Fun Writer bottle filled with Hi Ho Silver. Apply snowflakes on the boxes. You can also do this with a detail brush instead of the Fun Writer.

STEP 6- Dip into 1700 or 9000 Clear Glaze and fire to cone 06.
