Swirl Bowl

INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

2046 10" Stacking Bowl

FUN STROKES

FS- 2301 Smiley Face

FS- 2392 Rockin Red

BUMPY DOODLES

BD- 2507 Bumpy Black

Specialty Products

SY- 4436 Masque All

TOOLS

#8 and 12 Round Brush

Contact Paper

Synthetic Sponge

STEP 1- When you are wiping down the bisque to remove the dust, do not wipe down the rim of the bisque because the contact paper won't stick. Trace the pattern of the circle onto the contact paper, cut out and stick to the rim of the bowl.

STEP 2- Trace the pattern of the swirl to the inside of the bowl. Apply one generous coat of Masque-All to the part of the swirl that will be yellow starting at the center. Let dry.

STEP 3- Apply 3 coats of Smiley Face to rim. When this is dry peel off the contact paper. Apply 3 to 4 coats of Rockin Red to the inside of the bowl and the outside bottom area. Make sure the Masque-All is dry before you paint over it. Also apply 3 coats of Rockin Red to the circles on the rim.

STEP 4- Peel off the Masque-All and apply 3 coats of Smiley Face to the area where the Masque-All was. Clean up all edges. Dip into Clear Glaze and fire to shelf cone 06.

NOTE: SY- 4436 Masque All is a non-fired product that is used to masque off an area. It can also be applied to an unfired glaze area without affecting the color. It is liquid and dries like rubber so it can be peeled off easily before firing.
