INGREDIENTS

BISQUEFIRE

3004 Oval Coup Platter

FUN STROKES

FS- 2300 Polar Bear

FS- 2302 Orange Peel

FS- 2308 In The Pink

FS- 2313 Happy Trails

FS- 2314 Black Lab

FS- 2315 What a Yolk

FS- 2328 Mocha Chino

FS- 2333 Indian Summer

FS- 2341 Kermit

FS- 2348 Red Alert

FS- 2374 Blue Ice

4 and 8 Round Brush

Large Millinium Brush or a Mop Brush

MISCELLANEOUS

Sponge

Fun Writer

STEP 1- Sponge down entire platter and apply 2 coats of Polar Bear to the top side of the platter going around the edge.

STEP 2- Squeeze out a small amount of Blue ice, In The Pink and very little Polar Bear Squeeze out some water in the center of all three colors. Dab the sponge into the colors and the water. Apply to the whole top side of the plate so that all three colors are showing randomly as seen in photo. This goes on very damp. You should be able to see blue, pink and white and it should all be very light. Let dry

STEP 3- Trace the pattern onto the plate.

STEP 4- Side load a round brush with Happy Trails and apply a wavy edge as seen in the photo. Do this by wetting your brush, dab off slightly on a paper towel and slide one side of the brush into some Happy Trails then slide along inside edge of the wavy edge of the platter.

STEP 5- Apply 3 good coats of Mocha Chino to the turkey's body, head, neck and arms. Side load shade some Happy Trails to all the edges of the Mocha Chino areas. Wet your sponge and dab into some Chocolate Moose and scatter a little in the body area.

STEP 6- Apply 3 coats of Indian Summer to the collar area near the neck and one coat to the eyelids. Apply 2 coats of Polar Bear to the rest of the eye. Apply a one coat of Pumpkin Pie to make the iris of the eye and a coat of Black Lab to the pupils. Apply a highlight in the pupil with Polar Bear.

STEP 7- Apply 3 coats of Orange Peel to the beak and feet. Shade to the left of the beak and edges of the feet with a little Indian Summer. Apply 3 coats of Rockin Red to the wattle. Apply 3 coats of Red Alert to hat. Shade lightly with Black Lab.

STEP 8- Apply 2 coats of Pea Soup to the left flower on the hat. Apply What a Yolk to the right flower on the hat. Use the same colors to apply center dots opposite each other as seen in photo. Apply a coat of Kermit to the band on the hat.

STEP 9- Feathers: These are all done by watering the glaze down and putting very little color in the feathers. If you want them with a little more color then don't water the color down just apply one thin coat. The bottom feathers are Red Alert. The second row of feathers is Kermit and the third is What a Yolk. The last set of feathers have no color except for the shading.

STEP 10- All the shading is done by side loading with Happy Trails and applying to all the edges of the feathers.

STEP 11- Apply 2 coats of Black Lab to the male turkey's hat. Outline all the turkey with Black Lab. Write the letters in Black Lab also. You can use a detail brush or you can put some Black Lab into a Fun Writer bottle and write the words.

STEP 12- Dip into Clear glaze and fire to a shelf cone 06.
