# Bride & Groom Goblets

## INGREDIENTS

**Bisquefire**  
#4040 Goblet

**Fun Strokes**  
FS 2300 Polar Bear  
FS 2308 In The Pink

**Bumpy Doodles**  
BD 2500  
Bumpy Snow  
BD 2502  
Bumpy Pink

## Glaze

1700D Clear Dipping  
Glaze

## Brushes & Materials

#6505 Colorstix -  
#6 Round Brush  
#6520 Colorstix -  
#3/0 Detail Brush  
Synthetic Sponge

**Step 1-** Put some In The Pink and some Polar Bear on a paper plate or palette. Using your sponge squeeze out a little clean water in the center of the two colors. Dab the sponge into the combination of the water and colors and apply to the outside of the goblets excluding the stems. See wet stroke glossary.

**Step 2-** Apply 3 to 4 generous coats of In The Pink to the inside of the goblets and to the stems. Squeeze out the excess water from the sponge and apply some In The Pink to the top outer edge of each goblet.

**Step 3-** Trace pattern to the front of the goblets.

**Step 4-** Using the #6 round brush, wet, dab and side slide into the pink and apply to the bows. (See wet stroke glossary)

**Step 5-** Using the detail brush, outline the bow.

**Step 6-** Apply the letters "Bride" and "Groom" with Bumpy Pink and apply white dots on the base as shown in photo with Bumpy Snow.

**Step 7-** Dip into clear glaze and fire to shelf cone 06.

## WET STROKE GLOSSARY:

**WET STROKES:** A technique that is applied using water with color (similar to water colors), a round brush or a sponge to accomplish several different looks....watercolor...antique.....faded backgrounds.....old world look.....Weathered look.....deep shadowed look and parchment paper with burnt edges.

**WET & DAB:** Wet your brush and dab only once on the paper towel so you still have plenty of water in your brush.

**SIDE SLIDE:** Wet, then dab your brush once on a paper towel, slide one side of the brush through the edge of a color and apply by sliding along the inside edge of any design.

**DAMP SPONGE:** To wet your sponge and squeeze out all the water leaving it only damp.

**WET SPONGE:** Wet your sponge and squeeze out half the water so that the sponge is still wet.
