Gobble til you Wobble

INGREDIENTS

2315 What A Yolk
2341 Kermit

BISQUEFIRE

1017 - Square Rim
Dinner Plate

2347 Lady Bug
2354 Something Blue
2368 Old Yeller

FUN WRITER

2313 Happy Trails
2314 Black Lab

2372 Mocha Fudge
2377 Pumpkin Pie
2378 Pea Soup

FUN STROKES

2300 Polar Bear
2303 Lime Ricky
2305 Blue Heaven
2308 In The Pink
2313 Happy Trails

STEP 1 - Prepare the plate to shelf cone 04 bisque. On a paper plate, make 2 puddles of paint, using Something Blue on one side and White on the other side of the plate. Using a synthetic sponge, dip the sponge into clean water to fully soak the sponge. Squeeze out just a little water in between the blue and the white puddles, to water down the mixture. Dip the sponge (the rounded edge) into the plate to mix the watered down paints together. Apply the wet sponge to the inside part of the plate to give a pale washed out appearance, then let it dry. Transfer pattern onto the plate. On another paper plate, make 3 puddles of paint, using Pumpkin Pie, What A Yolk and Mocha Fudge. Using a synthetic sponge, dip the sponge into clean water to fully soak the sponge. Squeeze out just a little water in between the three colors and dip the sponge into the plate to mix the watered down paints together. Apply the wet sponge (rounded edge) to the rim, dabbing the sponge back and forth to get different effects of the three colors. Work the same sponge technique for the turkey body and head.

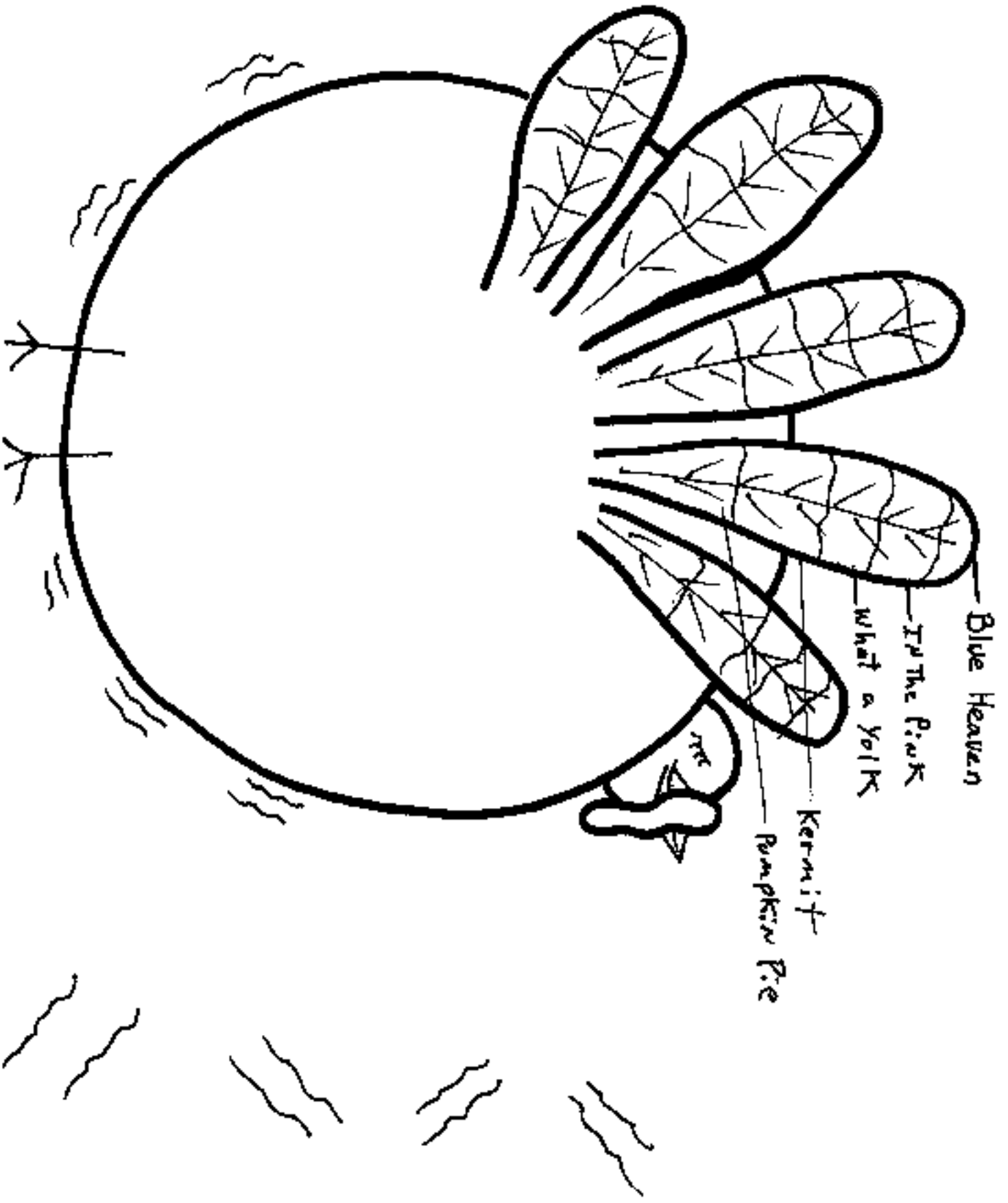
STEP 2 - Start working on the feathers from the top by using Blue Heaven at the top, using a size 6 round brush and just apply 1 coat. Refer to photograph as a guide. The next colors down the feather are as follows: In The Pink, What A Yolk, Kermit and Pumpkin Pie. Apply 2 coats of Lady Bug for the turkey's wattle and let dry. Apply a spot of Lady Bug for the turkey's cheek, by dipping your finger into the paint and then apply to the cheek area. Use 2 coats of Pumpkin Pie to the beak. Side load your brush with Happy Trails to highlight the inside part of the rim.

STEP 3 - Outline the turkey, feathers, face and legs with the Black Lab Fun Writer. Use the Happy Trails Fun Writer for the accent marks on the rim of the platter and to write out "Gobble til you Wobble". See photograph as a reference guide.
